 - The Chief Information Officer provided an update on this project, highlighting the dedicated and hard work of Rich Dixon who is leading this project. He has nearly completed the County departments and is starting the Shared Service agencies this week.
- NEW BUSINESS
 - Core Switch Migration
 - Ray Culliton is leading this project. This project provides the ability to create secure internal networks segregating both geographically separated and compliance regulated traffic. It also provides additional resilience and redundancy throughout the enterprise.
 - Host Infrastructure Migration

- The existing Top of Rack switches located in the data center at 56 Main Street have been migrated to the new core switches, significantly increasing bandwidth to our server hosts and storage area network appliances.
- Mobile Device Management
 - The County has started the migration of mobile device management (MDM) for all mobile devices from Sophos to our existing Remote Management and Monitoring (RMM) platform NinjaOne. This provides a single interface to support and manage all endpoint devices including desktop, laptop, and tablet computers as well as mobile devices such as phones and iPads.
